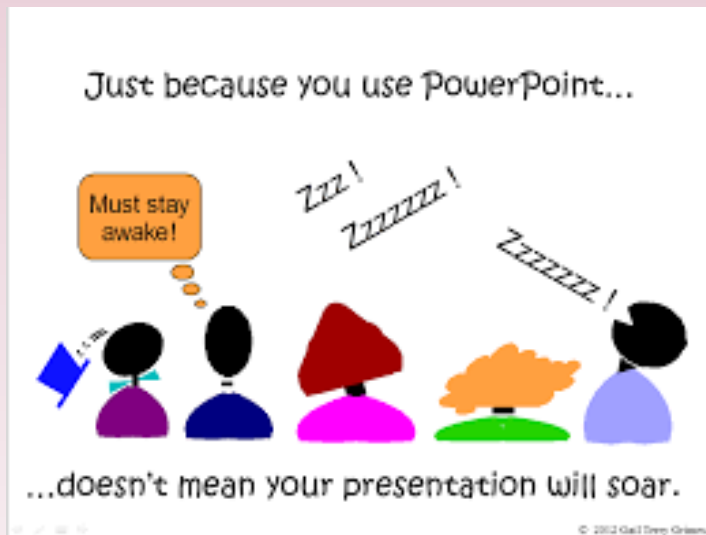

One Tip for All Presentations

Dr. Wilson will discuss the main obstacle to presentation effectiveness and how to make presentations more engaging so that the audience understands more. He explains the difference between a report and presentation and how most people present PowerPoint slides that should really be considered drafts, not the final presentation.
