
## **Accessing Engineering Virtual Lab**

Display Note: VMware only supports screen resolutions up to 2560 X 1440. Mac users will not have to change their screen resolution, but some PC users may.

- Download and install the Vmware Horizon Client
- Open the Vmware Horizon Client
- Add New Server >> <a href="https://eccvlab.egr.uh.edu">https://eccvlab.egr.uh.edu</a>




- Login with Cougarnet Account
- Launch Win7 K1 Desktop or Win7 K2 Desktop
- Click OK on the Welcome Screen, and you should be logged in.

## Connect a USB Drive

- Move the mouse to the top of the Horizon Client Window.
- Click on "Connect USB Device" from the toolbar at the top of the screen.
- Select your preferred option.



## **Logging Off**

- The VMWare View Client will present you with options to disconnect or logoff. If you disconnect, you can pick up your session where you left off if you reconnect within 30 minutes. If you log off you will free up your virtual desktop for other users immediately.
- You will be logged out of a virtual machine if you've been inactive for 30 minutes.

## **Saving Files**

- Important! Please save all your work to a USB (thumb) drive or a cloud based solution (Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.). Data saved to the virtual C: drive may not be recoverable after you logoff.
- Verify where you are saving your files. If you save a file under your user folder (such as C:/users/my\_user), you are saving it on the virtual C: drive, and it may be deleted when you logoff.
