### **Best practices for Webcam/Zoom recording**

**CAMERA SETUP AND VIDEO SAVING** 

If you have a Mac, follow these directions for recording and exporting:

### If you are using a smartphone or tablet:

Please record in horizontal (landscape) orientation from a stationary position at least 18-24" away from your face.

#### **RECORDING TIPS**

- Please record in **horizontal** (landscape) orientation from a stationary position at least 18-24" away from your face. **Center your head** and shoulders in frame. It is best for the camera angle to be **level or angled slightly down** toward your eyes than tilted upward.
- Find a quiet place without background noise or music.
- Natural daylight light is best, but try and avoid direct light which can cause shadows.
- If you have a laptop, **move it to a brighter room** if you have the option.
- If it is daytime and you have adequate natural window light, **TURN OFF other lighting** in your room as this will cast orange or blue casts on your face.
- If there's a window or bright lamp light source in your room, make sure it's either to your **side or in front of your face**, **NEVER behind your face**. If it is to your side, position your camera far enough away that the window itself is not visible or it will appear too bright.
- Remove any distracting items or clutter from backgrounds, but a splash of red or UH swag is always welcome!
- Project your voice! Talk just a little bit louder than you would normally face-to-face conversation.
- If you want to redo or record a second take, that's fine! Just **leave a short pause** of 1-2 second before starting your second (or third) recording.
- When you're finished, stay still for another 1-2 seconds with a smile or neutral expression. Don't immediately move away or shuffle around to stop the recording.
