Abstract:

The purpose of this presentation is to give an overview of scientific publishing and provide an introduction to the Royal Society of Chemistry. It will cover the role of a scientific publisher, how to write a paper, what is needed for submission, insight into the peer-review process, open access and publishing ethics.

Biography:

Jeremy joined the Royal Society of Chemistry in July 2014 as a Publishing Editor, starting in the journals: *Physical Chemistry Chemical Physics* and *Nanoscale*, before becoming the Deputy Editor for *Chemical Science* in 2018. At the beginning of 2022 Jeremy became the Executive Editor for *Materials Advances* and *Nanoscale Advances*, where he leads on the development of the journals, liaises with the Editorial Boards and oversees the production of articles. He is also the Executive Editor of recently launched journals *RSC Applied Interfaces* and *RSC Applied Polymers*. Prior to joining the organization, he completed a PhD at the University of Bath, UK and worked as a Post-Doctoral Research Assistant at Trinity College Dublin, Ireland. His research focused on the use of computational techniques for modelling reactions on surfaces and understanding the defect chemistry of oxide materials.
