To Play in the 3-on-3 Tournament:

- 3 players minimum is required. Each team is allowed to have a 4th/alternate player. All forms in this packet must be completed.
- The registration fee is **50 Canned Goods**, which can be brought the day of the tournament. Your spot is not held until all registration forms have been submitted. The last day for registration is April 04, 2015 or until all spots are filled.

- Space IS limited, so do not wait to sign up!

Rules:

- A Referee on each court will keep time and score.
- Each game will last for 15 minutes (running clock) or until 15 points are scored; whichever occurs first. The winning team must win by two.
- The alternate player can only substitute in-between games, unless there is an injury.
- Three pointer shots are worth 2 points and all other shots are worth 1 point.
- The championship game will last 20 minutes or until 15 points are scored; whichever occurs first. The winning team must win by two.
- Players must abide by UIL rules; they will be enforced by the Referees.
- Between possessions the ball must be taken back to the 3 point line; between points possession of the ball will be alternated.
- Referees will count all fouls. All fouls returns the ball to the team who was fouled. After 8 team fouls, the fouled team will receive free throws **and** will get the ball back.
- Respect your Referees; they have the final say!

WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY And ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

In consideration of being allowed to Participate in the Canned Food Drive Basketball Tournament, I, the participant, acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 1. I understand and have been fully informed about the risk of injury arising from my participation in activities at the facility, including the risk of significant injury such as cuts, bruises, broken bones, paralysis, etc... I also understand that the risk of injury from my participation in any activity may result not only from my own actions and errors, but also from the action or negligence of NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS staff, volunteers or other participants.
- 2. I agree that prior to my participation in any activity; I will inspect the facilities, equipment and areas being used. I also agree to comply with all terms, rules, signs and guidelines for participation in activities and I will encourage others to do the same. If I observe any condition which might be dangerous, in need of repair or maintenance, any unusual circumstance or behavior whether before or during my participation, I will not only remove myself from participation, I will immediately notify a NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS staff, volunteer or other participants.
- 3. Assumption of the risk, including negligence, knowing and being informed of the above: I freely assume all risks associated with my participation in any activity even if caused, in whole or in part by any act, error, omission, or negligence of NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS or others. I further assume any and all risks of bodily injury to myself or caused by me, whether the same shall arise by my negligence or the negligence of others, including NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS staff, volunteer or other participants.
- 4. Release of Liability/Indemnity: I hereby release and discharge NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS from all liability arising out of my participation in any activity, and hereby indemnify and hold harmless NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS staff, volunteer or other participants with respect to any and all injuries, disability, death, damage, and loss of whatever nature or kind arising out of my participation in any activity.
- 5. My insurance or none: I agree that I will either: (1) obtain my own insurance to cover any injury or damage which I might suffer or cause, or (2) I agree and understand that I am not covered by insurance at all and assume the risk of not having insurance. In either case, I will not seek to hold the NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS staff, volunteer or other participants or its insurers responsible or liable for any injury or damage which I suffer or cause. NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS and I waive our right to a jury trial and will let a judge decide all issues relating to this agreement, or any injury or damage arising from my participation.

When used herein,

"NSBE" means and refers to the National Society of Black Engineers. National Society of Black Engineers, South Houston NSBE Jr., and all of its partners, (general and limited), officers, managers, employees, staff, independent, contractors, sponsors, vendors, suppliers, agents and representatives, as well as their insurers, members, and all of their successors and assigns.

"I", "you" or "Participants" shall mean and refer to you the person(s) signing this Waiver, Release of Liability and Assumption of the Risk, and also refers to, and is binding upon Participants parents, guardians, heirs, executors, guests, spouse, next of kin, and members of your family.

"Facility" shall mean and refer to any locations, operated, leased, or controlled or occupied by NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS" including the facility, parking lots, fields and other areas surrounding the playing facility.

"Participate" or "Participant" shall mean and refer to any and all types of participation in any activity including but not limited to participation as a competitor, patient, client, spectator, observer, coach, assistant, referee, visitor or other guest of the Facility.

"Activity" or "Activities" shall mean and refer to any activity occurring at the facility or involving the sponsorship or participation of "NSBE" National Society of Black Engineers including but not limited to any and all games, events, tournaments, practices, programs, sessions, workouts, therapy training, meetings, gatherings, consultations, and other events.

"Risk of Injury" shall mean and refer to all possibilities of injury which may result or arise from participation in any activity. Without limiting the foregoing, such risks include being hit or struck by balls, bats, or other flying objects; straining, tearing or bruising muscles, tendons, joints and other body parts; breaking bones; aggravating prior to existing conditions; slipping, tripping or falling which may be caused by contact with other participants, aggressive play, or personal weakness or infirmity; and stroke, heart attack, heat stroke, dehydration and other physical and mental conditions which may arise or result from participation.
